Rules of Show and Conditions of Entry

- All timings for classes are APPROXIMATE and the Show Committee reserves the right to vary the order of the schedule and to refuse entry.
- All rider ages are as at the date of the show.
- All horses must be at least 4 years of age as of 1st January 2010.
- Correct riding attire to include hats to current Pony Club standards MUST be worn when mounted. For safety reasons competitors must not wear any jewellery.
- Entry fees refunded ONLY on production of doctor's or veterinary certificate.
- No claim can be entertained by the organisers for any loss, injury, damage, accident or illness caused to or suffered by any horse, pony, competitor, attendant, spectator or any other person, vehicle or any other property in connection with or arising from this event, whether or not the injury, loss or damage is caused by the negligence of the organisers, their servants or agents.
- All dogs must be kept on short leads.
- Blatant use of bad language or misuse of whip/spurs will incur elimination and not be tolerated. You will be asked to leave the show ground.
- For safety reasons cantering on the showground must only take place in the warm up areas.
- The Judge's decision shall be final in all events.
- Rosettes to six places in all classes and to all in the lead rein classes.
- ENTRIES CLOSE on Thursday 22nd July 2010. Entries on the day will be charged £2 extra, space permitting.
- Anyone wishing to lodge a complaint will be required to first deposit the sum of £20 with the Secretary within 30 minutes of the incident. If the complaint is not upheld then the £20 will be considered forfeit.

HEALTH & SAFETY: The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health & safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards.

SC&SH PONY CLUB MEMBERS ONLY

SC&SH Branch members are entitled to a £1 per class discount for all classes except Tack & Turn Out, Gymkhana and Clear Round. Only applies to postal entries received by the closing date. Please tick the box on the entry form.
