1. **Hats** must bear the CE mark and: **either** BSI Kitemark with PAS 015:1998 or EN 1384:1996 or BS EN 1384:1997 **or** Snell E2001 with the official Snell label and number **or** SAI Global symbol with AS/NZS 3838 1998 or AS/NZS 3838 2003.
2. Hats must be correctly fastened and worn by all competitors at all times when mounted.
3. NO DOGS ALLOWED AT ANY TIME.
4. Goodwood Pony Club and Boxgrove Competition Stables cannot be held responsible for any damage to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other persons or property, and it is a condition of entry that all rules must be accepted.
5. Any objection must be made to the Secretary, with a deposit of £10, not later than 30 minutes after the result.
6. We reserve the right to cancel classes if entries are insufficient.
7. No entries will be refunded without a veterinary certificate.
8. All classes will be judged under Pony Club rules unless stated.
9. In case of cancellation £2.50 of the entry fee per competitor will be retained for administration costs.
10. Cheques should be made payable to 'Goodwood Branch of the Pony Club'.
11. Entries in all classes will be limited.
12. Stallions will only be allowed to enter with the prior agreement of the organiser.
