SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

Class 1 Absolute Beginners Jumping 45-60 cm (1'6-2'0)
All double clear rounds will receive a rosette.

NB: To ensure a prompt start entries for this class will be given a time. Please look at the website for your time after 6.00pm on Thursday 16th February

If you are not ready at your allotted time you may not be allowed to jump.

Entrants in this class may not enter Classes 3,4 , 5 or 6

Class 2 Beginners Jumping 60-65cm (2'0-2'3)

Class 3 Novice Jumping 65-75 cm(2'3-2'6)

The Winner will receive the www.equibuys.com Perpetual Trophy

Not before 12.00pm

Class 4 Intermediate Jumping 85cm (2'9)

The winner will receive the Horns Farm Saddlery Perpetual Trophy

Class 5a Pony Club Dengie Winter League Preliminary Round Qualifier 85-90cm (2'9-2'11)

Class 5b Open to all
****Classes 5a and 5b will run concurrently****

Class 6 Open Jumping 3'3 (1.00m)

Classes 1 to 4 and 6 will be run in accordance with BS rules, (**except** in Class 1 when competitors will be allowed 2 disobediences before elimination) and will be two phase, i.e. all competitors who jump clear rounds in the first round will complete the jump off course immediately without leaving the arena.

Classes 5 will be run under Pony Club rules and in accordance with the Dengie Rule Book **and will also be two phase.**

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without giving a reason.
2. The decision of the judges and stewards in all cases is final.
3. Any objections must be made in writing and handed in to the show secretary within 15 minutes of the incident happening with a deposit of £10.00. In the event that the objection is sustained the deposit will be refunded.
4. The organisers will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, property or animal however caused.
5. Horses and ponies must be four years or older on the day of the show.
6. All competitors must be suitably dressed in correct riding attire. Hats must be approved PAS015, EN1384 or BS EN1384 with BSI kitemark and chin straps must be correctly fastened at all times when mounted..
7. All entries must be accompanied by the correct fee; each rider will be charged £3.00 extra towards the cost of First Aid.
8. All dogs must be kept on a lead.
9. The Organisers reserve the right to alter the programme of events at their discretion and should the event be cancelled for any reason the Organisers reserve the right to retain a proportion of entry fees to cover their expenses.
10. Classes 1 to 4 and 6 will be run in accordance with the rules of B.S.. However the wearing of half chaps will be permitted and competitors in Class 1 will be allowed 2 disobediences before elimination. Classes 5 will be run in accordance with Pony Club rules.
11. Class 5 is run under Pony Club Rules, including the Dengie Winter League Rules, copies of which can be obtained from Pony Club HQ or viewed on the Pony Club website, www.pcuk.org
12. Substitution of entries. A rider may request to substitute a horse/pony for a class that he/she has entered, if the secretary is so advised before the start of the class. **Horse and rider may not** be substituted —this is in effect a completely different entry!
13. In the interests of safety and the smooth running of the event, all competitors, their family and friends must follow the instructions of show officials, and this includes directions as to the parking of vehicles.
14. Please ensure that the area around your horse box/trailer is left clean and tidy! Tying of haynets on the outside of trailers/lorries is not permitted.
15. Horses/ ponies tied to the outside of trailers/lorries **must not** be left unattended.
16. There will be no refund of entry fees without production of a Doctor's certificate or Veterinary certificate within 7 days of the competition and any refunds made will be subject to an administration fee.
17. **Entry to events at Berkshire College does not entitle riders or visitors to use other equestrian facilities, including the grass rides and the cross country areas. Riders or visitors are not entitled to be anywhere on the estate other than the specific facilities hired as per the Booking Form. Anyone found on the estate will be banned from ALL future equestrian events at this venue."**
